SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

As part of the College Day Observance, which takes place on the third Sunday in May, the church and Scholarship Committee hopes to present two (2) fifteen hundred-dollar scholarship to two deserving graduating seniors from the Church. One of these scholarships has been named in memory of our former pastor, Rev. E. L. Grant and the other in memory of Sister Carrie Bitting, one who labored many years in the Church's Music Education ministry. The guidelines for applying for these scholarships are as follows:

- Applicants must be active members of First Waughtown Baptist Church.
- Applicants must have a 3.0 or above grade point average.
- Participation in extra-curricular, church and community activities will be considered as part of the criteria for selection of recipients.
- Applicants must have been accepted to some institution of higher learning. (university, college, technical school/college, community college, etc.)
- Applicants must turn in a letter of acceptance for the institution they plan to attend.
- Applications must be turned in along with two (2) letters of recommendation from two (2) high school teachers.
- A transcript of grades should accompany the application.
- Applicants must also write a statement indicating why they think they qualify for a scholarship.
- Application will be ranked by the committee according to the criteria stated.
- Applications must be submitted by April 12, 2020.
- The chosen recipients will be announced during the College Day Service. (3rd Sunday in May)
- If no applicants qualify, the scholarship will not be awarded.
